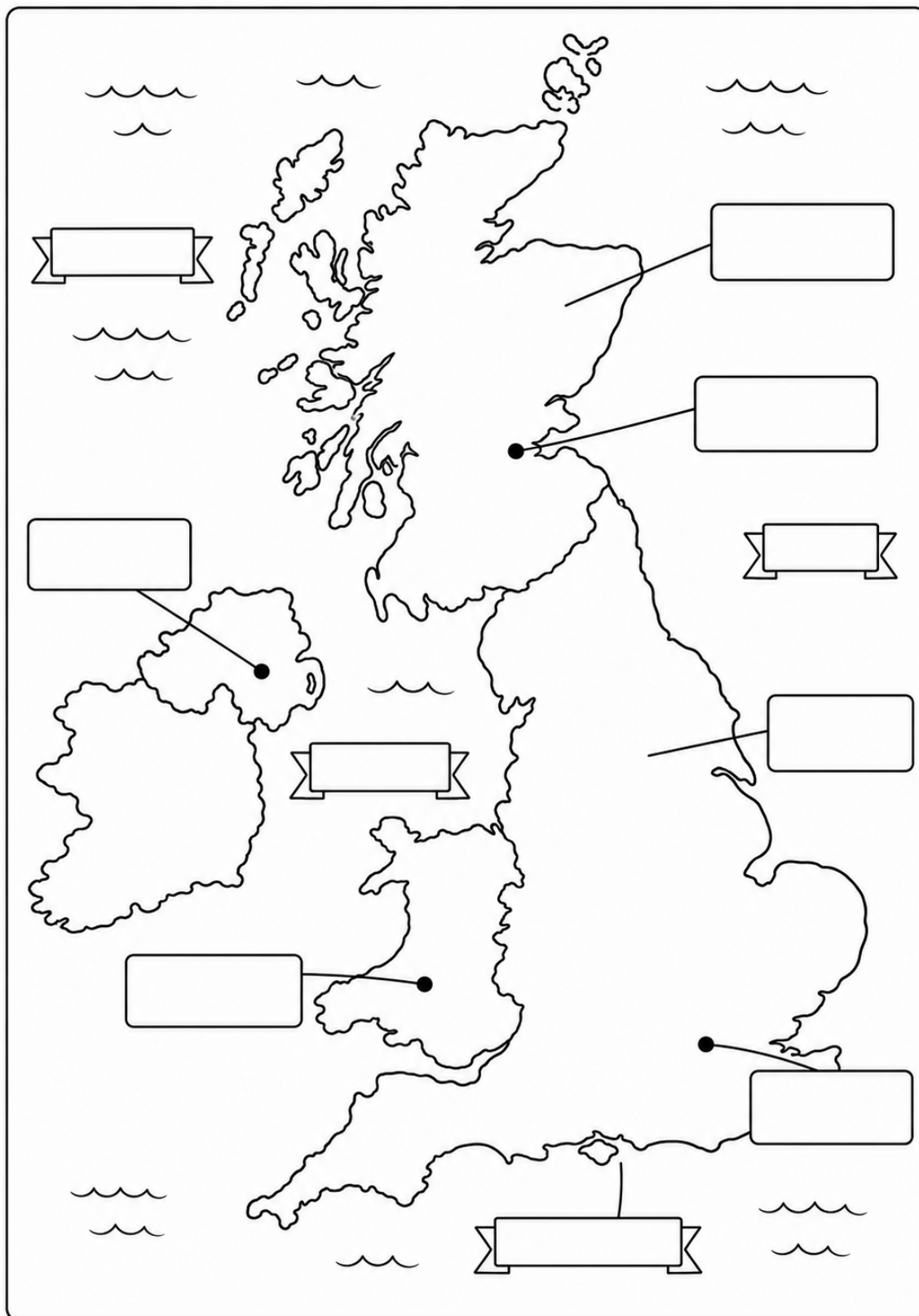

## Parent & Teacher Guidance

### Curriculum focus

Topic: United Kingdom. Develop accurate observation, subject vocabulary and evidence-based explanation. Mapped scope: KS1 Geography: naming, locating and identifying characteristics of the four UK countries and capital cities and surrounding seas, using maps and atlases..

### Before you begin

Review the picture together and ask the learner what they already notice about United Kingdom. Read the activity aloud, explain unfamiliar vocabulary, and agree which details need special attention.

### Solo activity

The learner can complete the colouring independently, then use the finished page to explain three details linked to United Kingdom. Encourage accurate colour choices where they carry meaning, but allow creative choices elsewhere.

### Group activity

Give pairs or small groups different areas to inspect. Ask them to agree on evidence before colouring, compare their findings, and present one curriculum fact to the class. Finish with a whole-group check against the guidance below.

### Questions to guide discussion

What evidence can you see? Which feature is most important and why? How does one part connect to another? What new fact about United Kingdom can you explain using the picture?

### Answers and checking

Scotland is the northern country and Edinburgh its capital; England is the largest southern country and London its capital; Wales lies west of England and Cardiff is its capital; Northern Ireland lies west across the Irish Sea and Belfast is its capital. The surrounding seas shown are the Atlantic Ocean, North Sea, Irish Sea and English Channel.
