Parent & Teacher Guidance

Curriculum focus

Topic: Germany 1890-1945. Develop accurate observation, subject vocabulary and evidence-based explanation. Mapped scope: DfE GCSE subject content and key stage 4 curriculum entitlement.

Before you begin

Review the picture together and ask the learner what they already notice about Germany 1890-1945. Read the activity aloud, explain unfamiliar vocabulary, and agree which details need special attention.

Solo activity

The learner can complete the colouring independently, then use the finished page to explain three details linked to Germany 1890-1945. Encourage accurate colour choices where they carry meaning, but allow creative choices elsewhere.

Group activity

Give pairs or small groups different areas to inspect. Ask them to agree on evidence before colouring, compare their findings, and present one curriculum fact to the class. Finish with a whole-group check against the guidance below.

Questions to guide discussion

What evidence can you see? Which feature is most important and why? How does one part connect to another? What new fact about Germany 1890-1945 can you explain using the picture?

Answers and checking

The timeline runs from Kaiserreich industrial and political tensions, through war and defeat, revolution and Weimar, Versailles, 1923 crisis, relative 1924-29 recovery, Depression and political crisis, Nazi dictatorship/rearmament, and 1939-45 war, persecution, destruction and defeat.
