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Parent & Teacher Guidance

Curriculum focus

Topic: Colour mixing. Develop accurate observation, subject vocabulary and evidence-based explanation. Mapped scope: KS1 Art and Design: developing techniques in using colour, line and shape through painting..

Before you begin

Review the picture together and ask the learner what they already notice about Colour mixing. Read the activity aloud, explain unfamiliar vocabulary, and agree which details need special attention.

Solo activity

The learner can complete the colouring independently, then use the finished page to explain three details linked to Colour mixing. Encourage accurate colour choices where they carry meaning, but allow creative choices elsewhere.

Group activity

Give pairs or small groups different areas to inspect. Ask them to agree on evidence before colouring, compare their findings, and present one curriculum fact to the class. Finish with a whole-group check against the guidance below.

Questions to guide discussion

What evidence can you see? Which feature is most important and why? How does one part connect to another? What new fact about Colour mixing can you explain using the picture?

Answers and checking

Circle: on the easel's top corner. Triangle: on the apron pocket. Star: on the palette rim. Leaf: beside the plant pot. Key: beneath the paint box. There is exactly one outlined clue token of each shape.
