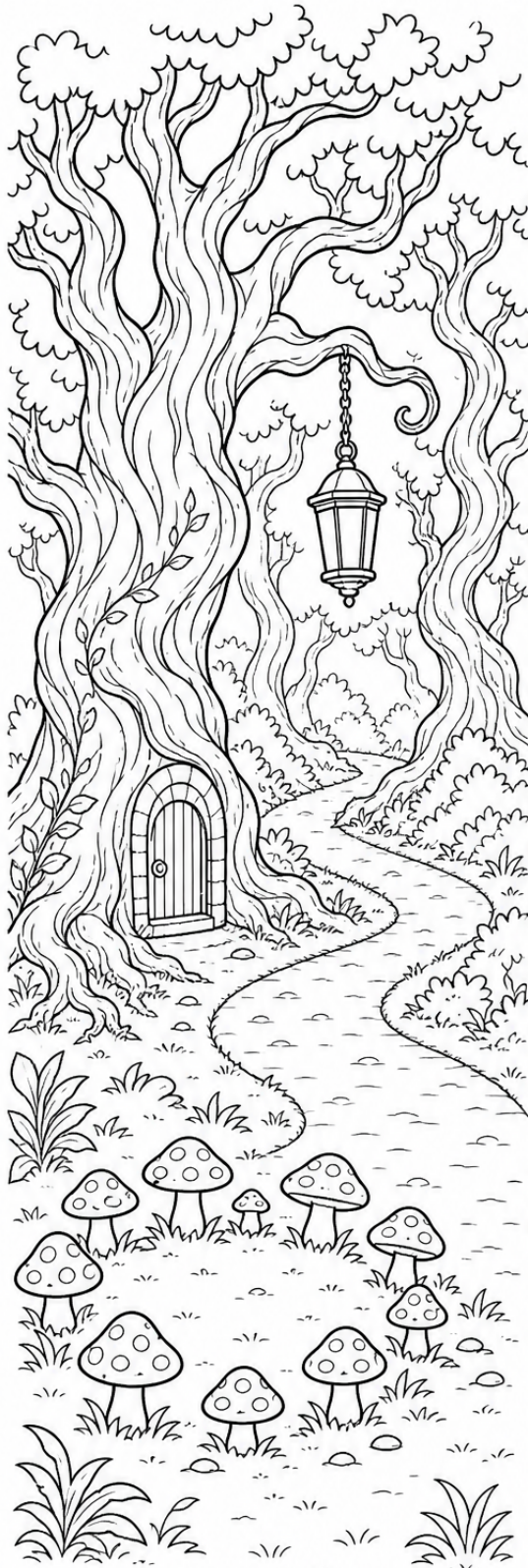


Story settings Vocabulary And Facts Colouring Page

Compare the enchanted forest and busy harbour. Find five setting clues in each, then choose where your story begins.



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Parent & Teacher Guidance

Curriculum focus

Topic: Story settings. Develop accurate observation, subject vocabulary and evidence-based explanation. Mapped scope: Year 2 English: discussing sequences and events in narratives, making inferences and predictions, and writing narratives about personal experiences and those of others..

Before you begin

Review the picture together and ask the learner what they already notice about Story settings. Read the activity aloud, explain unfamiliar vocabulary, and agree which details need special attention.

Solo activity

The learner can complete the colouring independently, then use the finished page to explain three details linked to Story settings. Encourage accurate colour choices where they carry meaning, but allow creative choices elsewhere.

Group activity

Give pairs or small groups different areas to inspect. Ask them to agree on evidence before colouring, compare their findings, and present one curriculum fact to the class. Finish with a whole-group check against the guidance below.

Questions to guide discussion

What evidence can you see? Which feature is most important and why? How does one part connect to another? What new fact about Story settings can you explain using the picture?

Answers and checking

Enchanted forest clues: twisted trees, mushroom circle, hanging lantern, winding path and tiny door in a tree. Busy harbour clues: lighthouse, fishing boat, dockside crane, warehouse and gulls. There are 10 specified setting clues altogether. Credit story ideas that use visible setting evidence.
